

SECTION 01520 - STAGING, LIFTS & ACCESS

PART 1 - GENERAL

1.01 RELATED DOCUMENTS: The general provisions of the Contract, including General and Supplementary Conditions, and all Division 1 sections of the Specifications apply to the work specified in this section.

1.02 SCOPE

- A. All staging, stairs, hoisting, rigging, lifts and access required to complete the work shall be provided by the General Contractor under Sections 06100 and 06200, Carpentry and Associated Work.
- B. The Contractor is responsible for obtaining and paying for permits, erecting and maintaining, in safe condition, all scaffolding, stairs and hoisting, and associated equipment required on the job. All work shall comply with OSHA requirements and the requirements of all applicable state and local laws, codes, regulations and ordinances. Specifically, the Contractor must designate a safety supervisor who is familiar with OSHA Publications 2202, 3077, and 3072, and those which deal with construction industry safety standards, personal protective equipment, and sling safety and labor. No swing staging shall be permitted without specific written approval of the Owner.
- C. The Contractor controls access to the work area and prevents unauthorized access to the work area and any area where there is danger from falling objects. The steeple entrances shall be closed to the public throughout construction. The Contractor shall maintain this security.
- D. Adjoining windows, roof and building surfaces shall be protected by the Contractor.
- E. Contractor to allow access by other trades.
